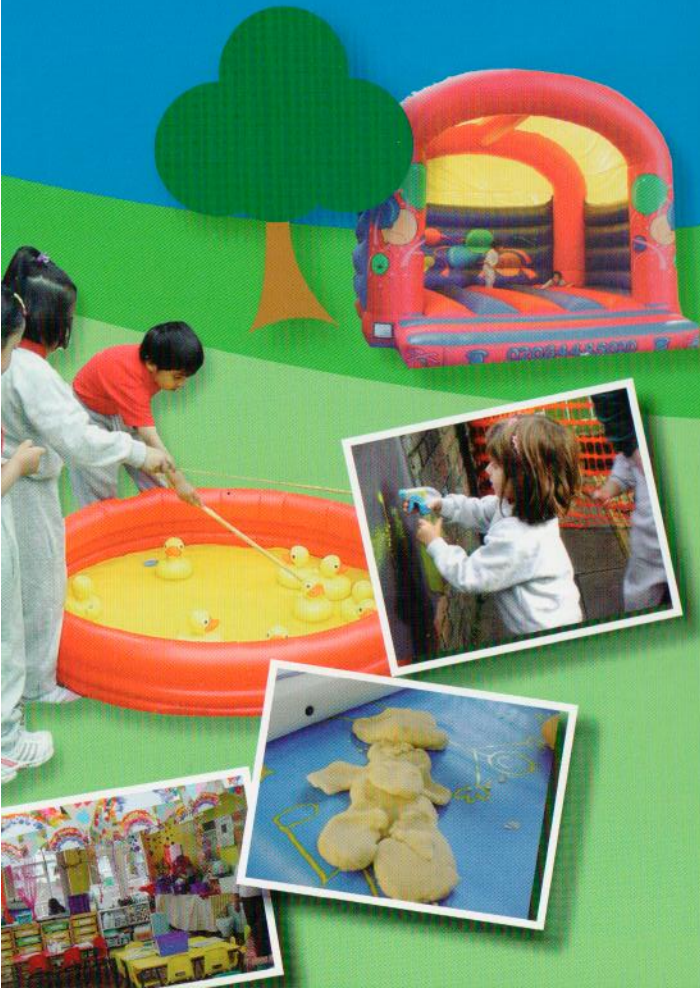


Holiday Club

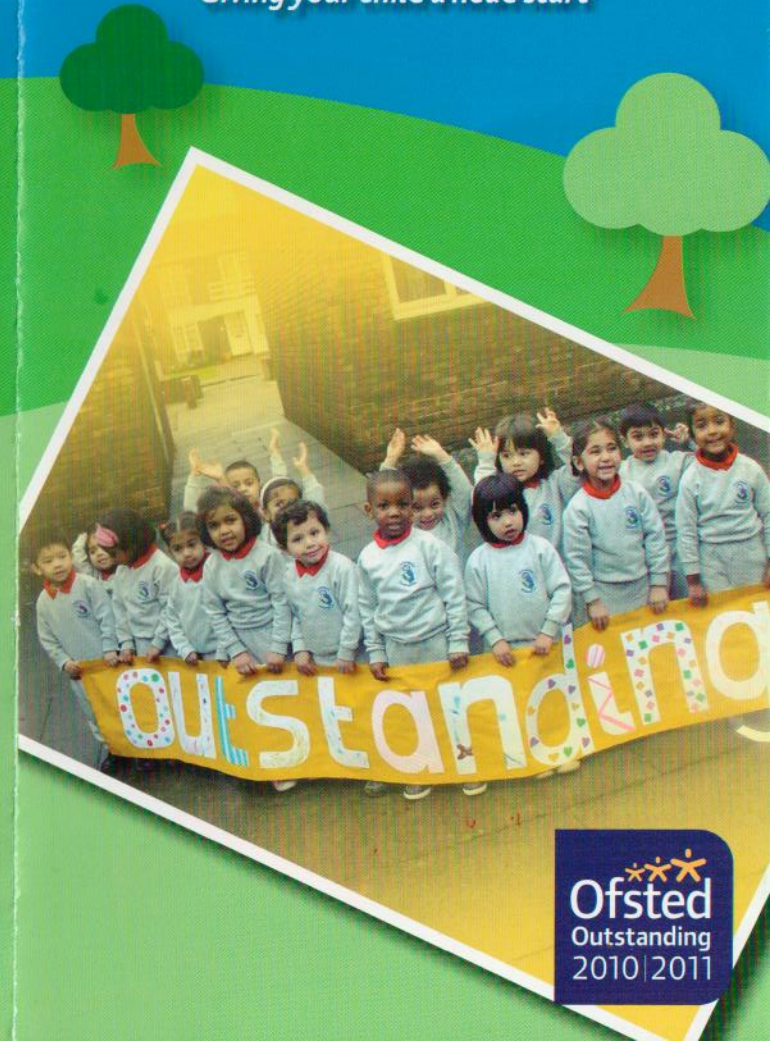
We are behind the Harrow Civic Centre and Harro Wealdstone Station off Marlborough Hill Road.

We are open 51 weeks per year. We also offer term time places with flexible options.

At Christchurch Kindergarten children flourish in a high quality and caring environment where learning is achieved in a fun and stimulating way whilst playing.

Our aim is to help each child meet their full potential in all areas of developmental needs. We are committed to developing your child's emotional and social confidence by providing opportunities for choices and decision making to enhance their interests and maximize their own abilities.



Curriculum

At Christchurch we believe in offering a wide range of teaching materials and learning methods to the children and not to restrict them to one particular method of teaching. By doing this we believe that each individual child can excel to the best of their ability.

We follow the Curriculum Guidance for the Early Years Foundation Stage, in order to help prepare your child for when they start school. Within the curriculum are the six key areas of learning which are:

- Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- Communication, Language and Literacy
- Problem Solving, Reasoning and Numeracy
- Knowledge and understanding of the world
- Physical Development
- Creative Development

In conjunction with the educational programme we offer Stretch and Grow as an extra curriculum activity.

Mrs Vaghela is qualified in NVQ3 Childcare and Education and NVQ4 in Management of Childcare. She is currently studying for a Childcare Foundation degree at Trent University. She maintains a full time presence within the Kindergarten alongside the excellent team of qualified, dedicated and friendly staff.

All our staff are qualified and highly experienced, including trained paediatric First Aiders, Special Educational Needs, Health & Safety. Staff regularly attend courses, updating their knowledge, training, skills and understanding.
