The Green Cross Code – Finding a Safe Place to Cross

- Where you can, try to cross the road using a zebra crossing, pelican crossing, an underpass, a footbridge or with the help of a lollipop person.

Zebra Crossing

No traffic lights but black and white stripes on the road and beacons.



Footbridge

A path which goes over the road.

Pelican Crossing

With traffic lights and a green man.

What does the red man mean?



Lollipop Person

A person you might see near to your school who can help you to cross the road safely.



Underpass

A path which goes under the road.
